Guidance:

Note 1. Permits to Fly are issued to aircraft where the requirement for the issue of a Certificate of Airworthiness are not met. In the Overseas Territories this is generally as a result of a type approved aircraft not fully complying with certification requirements. This may for example, be because the maintenance of the aircraft is not up to date and the aircraft requires to be flown to a place where the required maintenance can be performed.

If a Noise Certificate is required, the application should contain the data as defined in OTAR Part 36. A noise certificate will be issued by the TCI CAA alongside the C of A.

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- Note 2. The manufacturer and type designation of the engine type is required.
- Note 3. The manufacturer and type designation of the propeller type is required. The engine/propeller combination must comply with the Type Certificate Date Sheet or Approved Alternative.
- Note 4. Original documents are not required at the time of application. The original documents will be viewed by the surveyor at the time of the C of A / Permit to Fly Issue.
- Note 5. The applicable Flight Manual Reference status is required.
- Note 6. The maintenance programme/schedule must be approved by the TCI CAA.
